#### MEDITATION FOR TODAY

Noah endured the forty-day devastation of the flood. In a similar way, the Spirit today drives Jesus into the forty-day trial of the desert. Satan conspires to make Jesus compromise his relationship as Son to his Father. But Jesus remembers how the flood ends with God's promise: "I will establish my covenant with you." The Father now perfects that promise in the flesh of his own Son, who will "show sinners the way" so that "he might lead you to God." The temptations reveal that Jesus is unshakably certain of his Sonship. Through our trials the Father's care shines.

# Please Join the Parish in Congratulating Joyce Lemon as Knights of Columbus Council 11817 Parishioner of the Month for February

Joyce (Pelland) Lemon moved to Castle Hayne in the mid 50s and attended St. Stanislaus Catholic School. She was a parishioner at St. Stanislaus for ten years before leaving home and going to college, etc. She then moved back permanently in 2012 and immediately joined the choir and started attending the daily masses. Joyce then began assisting setting up the masses as a daily Sacristan. Father Roger then asked her to take over Evangelization on the Pastoral council four years ago. She and the Evangelization team were able to plan ways to spread the faith. They implemented the use of Welcome Packets for newcomers and placed a weekly MESSAGE on the outside bulletin board. When St. Stanislaus received the Via Crucis from Dr. Tamisiea, Joyce saw it as a further means of Evangelization and promoted its use having a Stations of the Cross once a month.

Four years ago, after obtaining a Master Catechist Certificate through the diocese, Father asked Joyce to head up RCIA in our parish. She completed a special workshop through TEAM RCIA and happily took on the task. At the same time, she was able to begin some adult formation classes such as SEARCH. Joyce took some personal religious education courses from groups like FORMED enabling her to procure FORMED for our parish and planned on following up with more adult classes. The next adult class will be on the Holy Eucharist in connection with the third year of the Eucharistic Congress.

As an RCIA (now OCIA) catechist, Joyce stresses the need for personal prayer for our catechumens and/or candidates and full participation at the Mass. She reminds everyone of the weekly MMP Cenacles that were begun when she first moved back to St. Stanislaus in 2012. For the personal spiritual growth of our parish, we also provide Advent and Lenten booklets. Joyce continues to offer her services to the new Evangelization team. She will continue to place a weekly message of Evangelization in the bulletin.
