

MEDITATION FOR TODAY

Worldly glory is fleeting. Christ enters into Jerusalem to the tune of crowds chanting, "Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord!" Only five days later, the same crowd cries, "Crucify him! Crucify him!" How their fickleness contrasts with the constancy of Jesus, for he remains faithful, humble, "obedient to death, even death on a cross." Despite beatings, insults, and spitting, Jesus knows full well that he will "not be put to shame." United to him, neither will we. In his Passion, we find forgiveness of our sins and the strength to rise above persecution, injustice, and suffering.
