MEDITATION FOR TODAY

To “take refuge in the Lord,” the Good Shepherd, requires that we first face up to our own powerlessness, our limitations, and our need to follow someone if we want to experience true fulfillment in our life. Unlike literal sheep, we are aware of the risk that our Shepherd takes: “A good shepherd lays down his life for his sheep.” Therefore, we exclaim, “See what love the Father has bestowed on us!” More than merely knowing the Shepherd’s voice, we know his name “by which we are to be saved.” Because we agree to be sheep, “we are God’s children now.”
