At Pentecost, it is revealed that we remain always intimately united to our heavenly Father, who will shepherd his people home to the glory of heaven. "On that day, the Holy Trinity is fully revealed. Since that day, the Kingdom announced by Christ has been open to those who believe in him: in the humility of the flesh and in faith, they already share in the communion of the Holy Trinity. By his coming, which never ceases, the Holy Spirit causes the world to enter into the 'last days,' the time of the Church, the Kingdom already inherited though not yet consummated" (CCC 732).

**May 19–Pentecost Sunday**

Solemnity Depending on which year is used in today's liturgy, Our Lord shares information on the Holy Spirit with his apostles. He lets them know that the Holy Spirit will be given to them. In John 20:19-23 (a week after his resurrection), he breathed on them the Holy Spirit giving them the power to forgive sins. Before his death in John 15: 26-27, he lets them know that an advocate will come...the Spirit of Truth. Today, we are reminded of the first Pentecost which took place fifty days after Our Lord's resurrection when we read Acts 2:1-11..."tongues as of fire parted and came to rest on each one of them." Today we pray...Come, Holy Spirit, come!

**In Honor of our Blessed Mother**

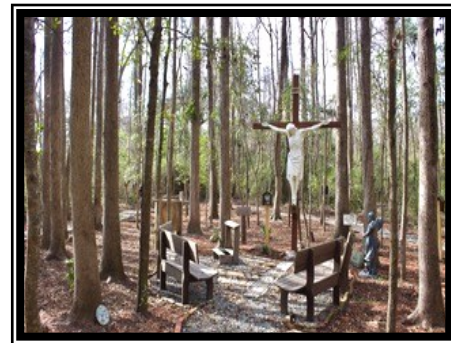


During the month of May we will be reciting the Rosary each weekend before Mass.
