

#### **MEDITATION FOR TODAY**

Cornelius, a Roman soldier, falls at the feet of Peter, not because of Peter's natural goodness, but because Jesus had chosen and appointed Peter to bear fruit. "The Lord makes his salvation known" through the love borne by the apostles. Cornelius symbolically lays down his life for his friend Peter, who will soon replicate that gesture in martyrdom. "Let us love one another, because love is of God."
