## MEDITATION FOR TODAY

Jesus silences the murmurers by saying, “No one can come to me unless the Father who sent me draw him.” What does it mean to “listen to the Father?” It means being “imitators of God, as beloved children, and living in love.” What the doubters in the Gospel find so far fetched—“I am the living bread that came down from heaven”—is exactly what the Father’s love makes possible, just as Elijah is rescued from starvation by miraculous food and drink. “Christ loved us” by handing himself over for us “as a sacrificial offering” that we might “taste and see the goodness of the Lord.”

Click on the Education tab. Then click on Faith Formation. Print the registration form and fill out ALL information. Submit the completed form to St. Stanislaus (along with payment). The fee for the class is \$50. Please write Faith Formation on the envelope and drop in the collection basket during Mass. If you have not yet registered as a parishioner, you may do so on the website as well. We ask that all families registering children for our Faith Formation program be registered parishioners of St. Stanislaus. For **all new students** we will need a copy, front and back, of your child's Baptismal Certificate. Please include that along with the registration form and payment.
