St. Stanislaus has a Ministry of Visitation and Prayer. This is a team of parishioners who can visit the sick and some can also bring Holy Communion to them.

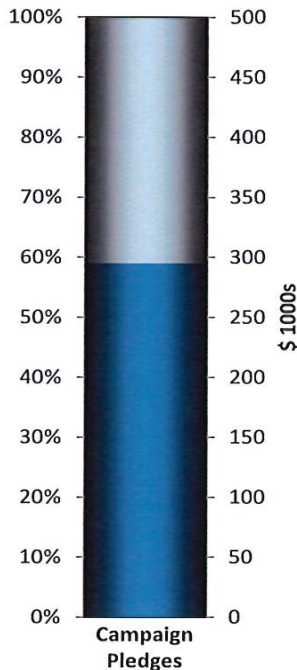

### **Twenty– Ninth Sunday in Ordinary Time**

All of the Readings today give us clues as to who Jesus is...In Isaiah 53, He gives his life as an offering for sin. In Psalm 33, He is our help and our shield. In Hebrews 4, He is able to sympathize with our weaknesses. In Mark 10, He did not come to be served but to serve. Like us, He was human in every way, but unlike us, he never sinned. Which is why we are able to confidently approach him who we trust, asking as in the Collect that we may always conform our will to His.
