

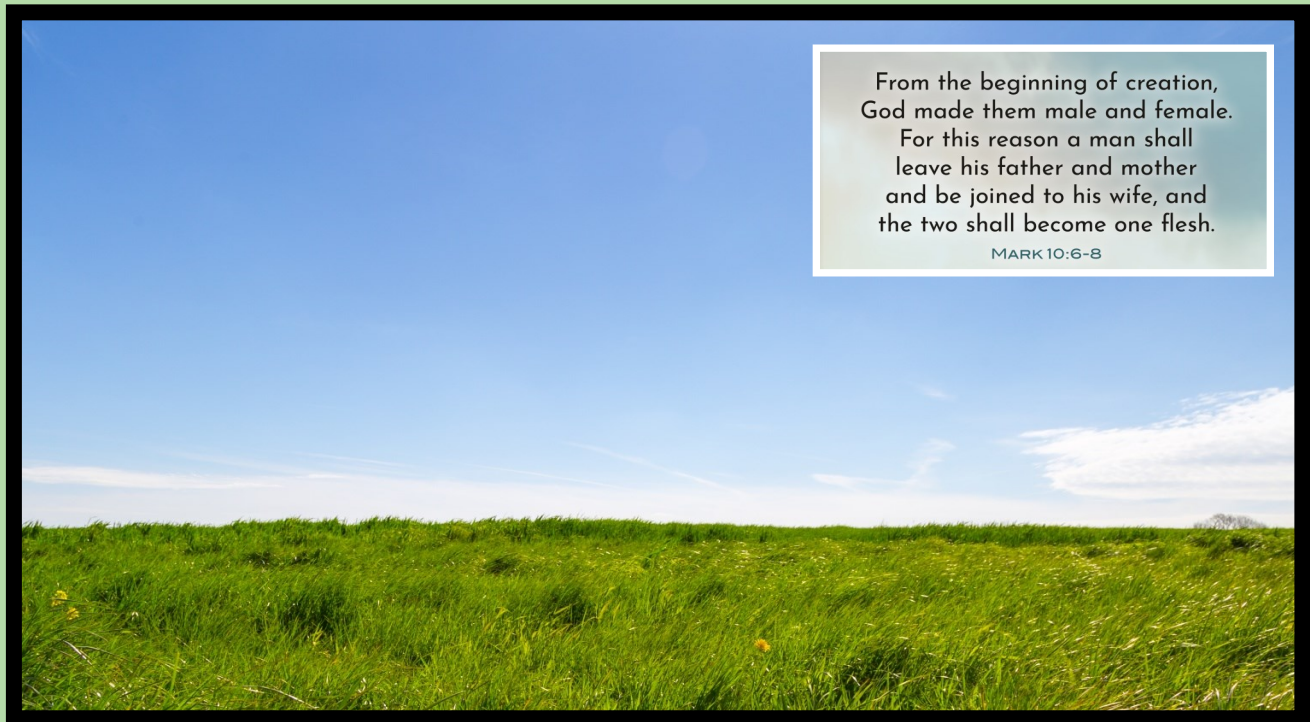

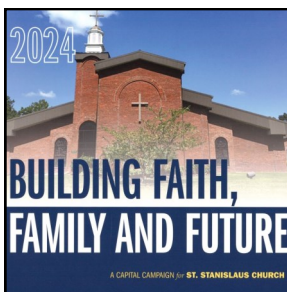
### Twenty– Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time
