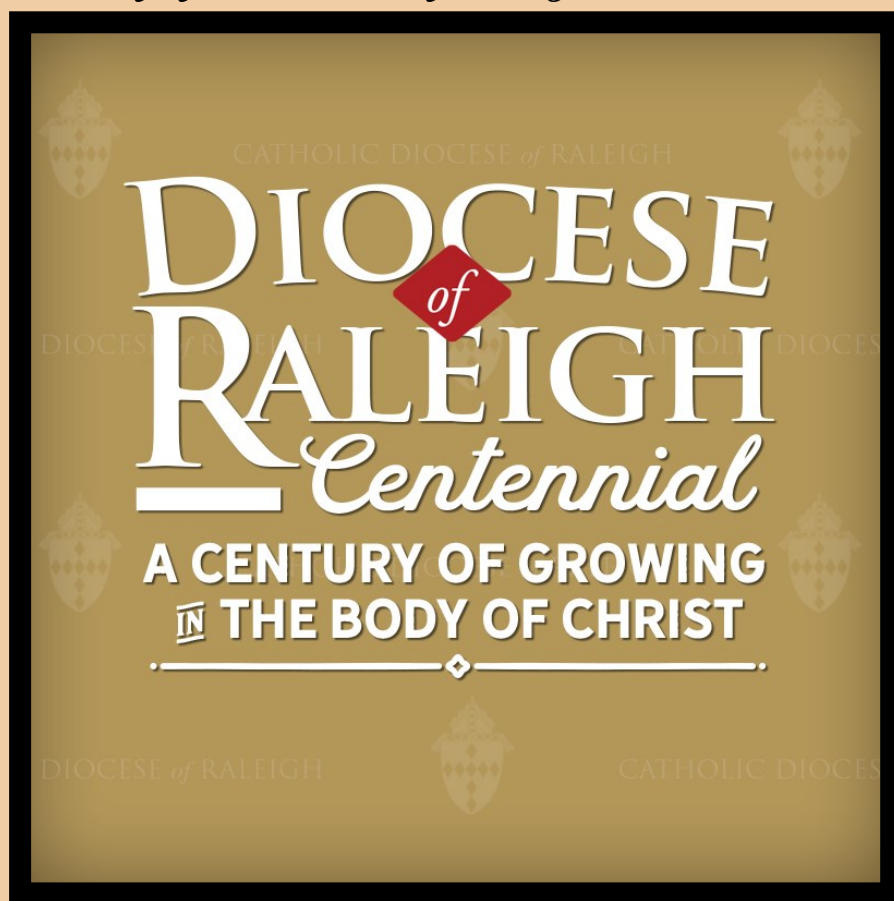

## Evangelization

### Thirty-Third Sunday in Ordinary Time

It's important to note that these readings today, about the end of the world, are taking place because we are at the end of the liturgical year. The time when he will indeed return. "In the days after the tribulation, the sun will be darkened, and the moon will not give its light, and the stars will be falling from the sky..." Mark 13:25. We know Jesus' words are true...we don't know when his prophecy will take place. In the meantime, we persevere trusting in Him completely and continue in his plan of salvation that was set up for us. We pass on the faith to those who come after us and fight the good fight with the help of his Church that was set up for us over two thousand years ago.

It is important that you sign up **BEFORE** the date of the event. The number of persons who sign up will determine if BUNCO occurs.

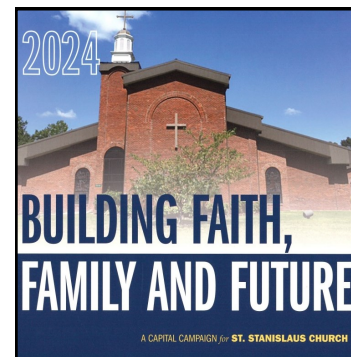
I look forward to seeing your name on the sheet in the gathering area, or to receiving a call from you to attend this Ladies' Guild sponsored event.
