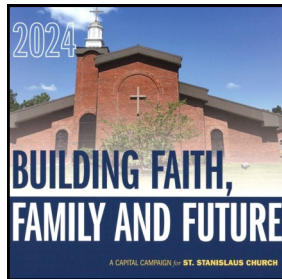

With \$467,000 of pledges our loan amount would be \$323,000.
