

Evangelization First Sunday of Advent December, 2024

Advent begins a new cycle in the Church's liturgical year-Cycle C. In today's Gospel message of Luke 21:25-28, 34-36, Jesus describes the events of his final (second) coming. "Be vigilant at all times and pray that you have the strength to escape the tribulations..." For some, the event will make some 'die of fright'. For others who have been 'vigilant', they will almost die of joy because they will see their Lord coming to them with "power and glory". We may not live to see the end of the world, but we will live to see the end of 'our' world. Are you ready? Today is the time to get ready by believing, praying, repenting and turning our lives over to Him. His first coming two thousand years ago, provided us the means to be ready...the Church, God's crowning achievement. Through it, we are able to encounter Him along with a communion of believers united with God in Christ through the sanctifying power of the Holy Spirit.
