

MEDITATION FOR TODAY

When people come to John the Baptist asking, "What should we do?" he says in effect: "Live generously and honestly with others, and don't live for material satisfaction only." With that advice, "the people were filled with expectation, asking in their hearts whether John might be the Christ." What follows, however, is John's revelation not of what they must do, but what Christ will do: "He will baptize you with the Holy Spirit and fire," and will bring his winnowing fan to clear out the chaff of sin from our souls. Our anxiety dissipates and rejoicing floods in when we realize our salvation comes from "a mighty savior" who "renews us in his love."
