## **Evangelization**

### Fourth Sunday of Advent December 22, 2024

Today's Gospel message is the "Visitation" and it brings up a number of questions for us to think about:

- 1. Who was Jesus' youngest disciple?
- 2. Who was the first person to confess the first Christian creed-Jesus is Lord?
- 3. How did Elizabeth know that Mary's baby was the Lord, that he was divine?
- 4. How did Elizabeth figure out the theology of the Incarnation?
- 5. Why did Elizabeth say "Blessed are you among women?
- 6. How did John the Baptist recognize Jesus from inside Elizabeth's womb?

Mary's role in our lives is and always has been to point the way to Jesus. She is to be imitated in our lives. She is what we are all designed to be— Christ centered.
