#### MEDITATION FOR TODAY

Why did Jesus, the all-holy Son of God, seek John's baptism of repentance? It was not to receive—for he is himself the source of all grace—but to give. "Christ is baptized, not to be made holy by the water, but to make the water holy, and by his cleansing to purify the waters which he touched" (Saint Maximus of Turin). Christ's baptism reveals to us what our own baptism now accomplishes: the forgiveness of sin and a share in his divine sonship.
