Like Abishai, in our fallenness we prefer “to nail [our enemy] to the ground.” How is it possible to take seriously what Christ tells us? Because he only commands what he makes possible: Jesus, the new Adam from heaven, gives us his own love, beyond our passions, impulses, defects, and fatalism. The Lord repays justice and faithfulness by making us bear the image of the heavenly second Adam.

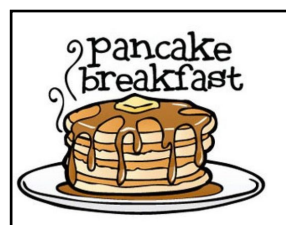
