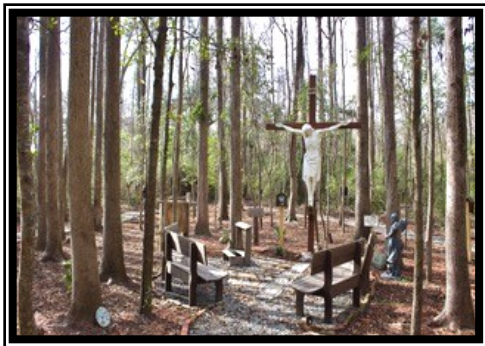
## Evangelization

**March 9, 2025**

**First Sunday of Lent**

Holy Lent: a yearly observance to help us to grow in understanding of the riches hidden in Christ and by worthy conduct pursue their effects— (Collect for March 2, 2025). It is a time to realize today's Gospel acclamation- "One does not live by bread alone, but on every word that comes from the mouth of God." A word full of knowledge and truth as displayed in today's Psalm 91...a psalm full of promises in times of trouble. "The word is near you, in your mouth and in your heart—that is the word of faith..."-Romans 10:8. A faith that saves us as we strive to live by it.
