April 13, 2025 Palm Sunday

On Palm Sunday, we stand with the crowds who welcomed Jesus into Jerusalem shortly before the annual Passover rituals. Then, suddenly our circumstances take us straight from praise to lament as the Triduum displays for us a yearly reminder of the Paschal mystery; Holy week—the climax of the Lenten season and the holiest week of the year.
