MEDITATION FOR TODAY

With the outpouring of the Holy Spirit on Pentecost, Christ's Paschal Mystery was brought to completion. The Holy Spirit, by his presence within us, causes us to be true Christians—other Christs. He frees us from being “debtors to the flesh” and strengthens us with his gifts. He reconciles us to God, giving us the status of adopted sons and daughters. Saint Thomas Aquinas says that the Holy Spirit interiorly perfects our spirit, communicating to it a new dynamism so that it refrains from evil, not simply out of fear of punishment, but for love. “The first gift of love is love itself, and all the other gifts emanate from this supreme gift, as from their source. Therefore, the Gift of the love of God is the Holy Spirit. The Holy Spirit does not give himself to us without pouring charity into our heart” (Servant of God Luis María Martínez).

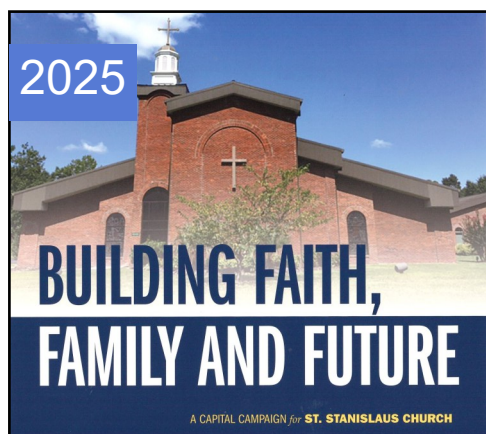
